Multipurpose agenda for sustainable development,
the plan of activities for nations made by nations in the interests of nations



UNESCO declares the importance of



- available inclusive and high quality education for SDG;



- protection of cultural heritage and combating illicit trafficking in cultural property;



- overcoming the crisis in the field of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM)



- investments aimed at supporting young people for access to quality education in order to combat extremism;



- freedom of expression and access for information and knowledge about sustainable development;



- encouragement of gender equality empowerment and equality of women for SDG.

The sustainable development goals recognize education as the main factor of development

Education is a part of the goals for health, economic growth and employment, sustainable consumption and production, and climate change, can also eliminate poverty, change lives and contribute to each of SDG (Incheon Declaration "Education-2030", 2015 .)



Development of natural sciences

UNESCO is part of the UN Task Team, which heads the global mechanism for promoting technological development

Objectives of UNESCO's programs in the field of natural sciences:

1. support developing countries in strengthening their scientific and technological capabilities

2. assistance in developing of the effective policies based on best practices, including knowledge of the local population and indigenous peoples

3. the formation of the common culture for robust communities



Development of natural sciences (2)

- ✓ UNESCO's mandate in the areas of competence – education, science, culture and communication
- ✓ More than 30 programs aimed at increasing knowledge and attracting public attention to the issue of climate change
- ✓ International Hydrological Programme (UNESCO-IHP)
- ✓ The Man and the Biosphere Programme (MAB)
- ✓ Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES)



Development of social and human sciences

Recognition for universal values and principles

Aims:

- Promotion of the cultural literacy spreading and creating new opportunities for dialogue and cooperation.
- Strengthening the culture of peace.

Initiatives:

- creating a global partnership to combat all forms of discrimination;
- formation of attitudes and behavior conducive to social integration and combating discrimination and intolerance among young people;
- capacity building in measurement and monitoring of the SDGs.

SDGs:

- the opportunity to promote research, the development of standards and the dissemination of knowledge of human rights in the field of competence of UNESCO
- the right to enjoy the benefits of scientific progress (REBSP)

Culture:

- reflects our essence and shapes our self-awareness
- contributes to poverty reduction and provides the basis for inclusive and equitable, people-focused development



Communication and information



Special Initiative on Knowledge-Driven Media Development:

- the importance of generating and sharing of knowledge to advance media development
- special relevance to an inclusive approach to strengthening journalism education worldwide



The YouthMobile UNESCO Initiative :

- Young girls and boys are introduced to coding as both a resource to solve local issues and as a tool to develop complex learning skills.
- Students are encouraged to develop, promote and eventually sell mobile applications as the key to ensure sustainable development.
- YouthMobile is strongly committed to the Sustainable Development Goals, in particular Goal 10 on reducing inequalities.
- It promotes the creation of inclusive digital societies and it strives to unlock the potential of women in ICT, fostering gender equality.

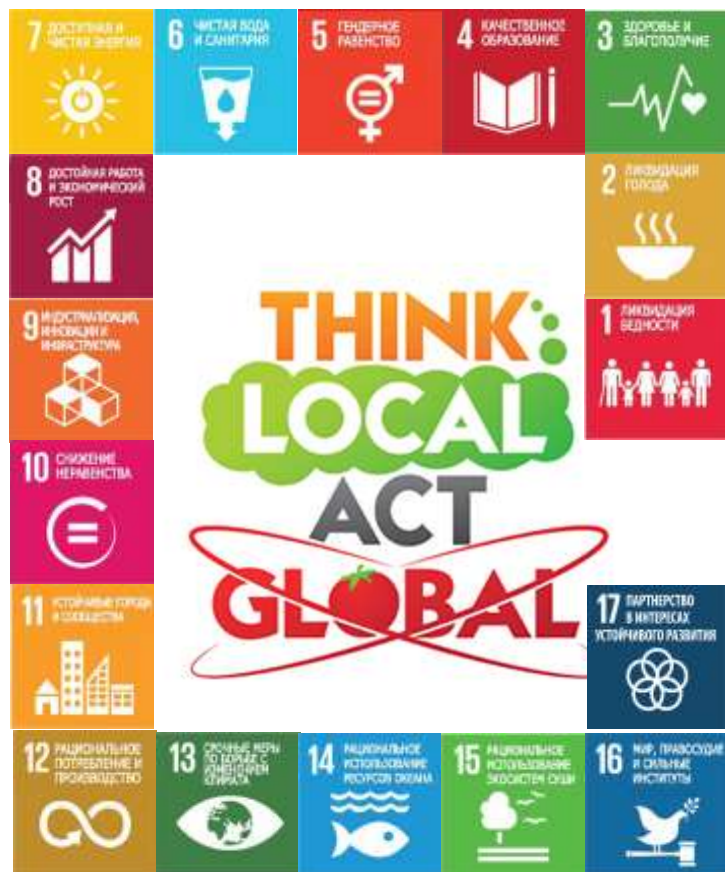
International youth initiatives

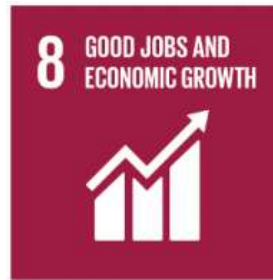

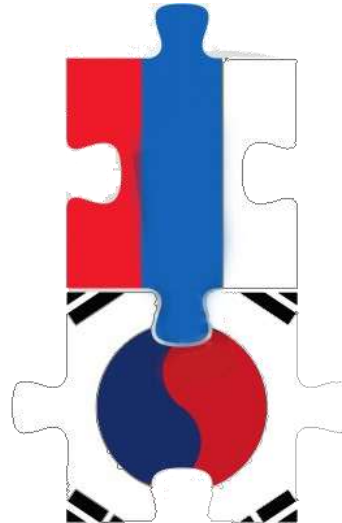
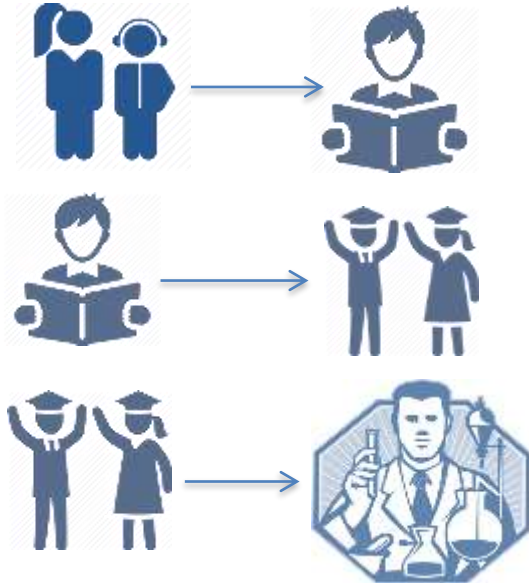
